- Treatment of approximately 700 acres of aquatic vegetation

- Maintenance of approximately 150 miles of District right-of-ways through mowing, aquatic treatment and harvesting, canal dredging, and repairing and/or replacing structures

 Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District is continuing efforts to control sediment and turbidity from entering the Indian River Lagoon

Trends and Issues:

- Water quality is a major issue throughout the District
- Treatment of aquatic vegetation through aquatic harvesting before it discharges into the Indian River Lagoon
