Helen and Allen Cruikshank Scrub Sanctuary

Trail Map

Description:

Visitors to the Cruickshank Sanctuary can hike the one-mile nature trail on the western portion of the 168-acre sanctuary. This trail winds through pine flatwoods habitat where a variety of birds may be circling overhead or perched in high pine trees. Patches of oak, sand pine scrub, and freshwater depression marshes add to the Sanctuary's diversity.

Parking:

Parking is located at 360 Barnes Blvd in Rockledge. Hours for parking are dawn until dusk.

Trail Instructions:

The one-mile loop trail is a relaxing way for visitors to observe area wildlife including the Florida Scrub Jay. The kiosk at the trailhead details some of the information for the site. As you begin the trail, the first 50 yards will bring you over a small bridge and into the scrub habitat. The northern most portion of this loop trail will bring you to a small overlook where some of the Florida Scrub Jays in the area can be better seen.
