Duct Tape Wallet



Supplies

Duct tape

Ruler

Scissors or utility knife

Directions:

Cut four strips of duct tape, each 9'' long. With the adhesive side up, stick the duct-tape strips to one another in a row, with a 1/4'' overlap.

Make a second sheet. Carefully stick the adhesive sides of the two duct-tape sheets together, lining up the edges.

Cut another 9" strip of duct tape. Use a utility knife or scissors to make a small cut in the center of one end of the duct tape. Tear the strip into two straight 1" strips.

Fold and adhere the 1" duct-tape strips to the 9" ends of the sheet. This will make a smooth, clean finished edge

Using the scissors or utility knife, trim the sides of the sheet, making it 8 1/2" wide.

Fold the sheet in half.

Tear two 1" x 4" duct-tape strips and attach one to each end. Fold them over the sides of the wallet, and trim the excess.

To make a smaller pocket for cards, cut two strips of tape each 5" long and stick the two pieces (adhesive sides) together.

Fold and adhere a 1" strip onto the 5" edge. Trim the pocket to 4" long.

Using 1/2" strips of duct tape, stick the pocket in place as shown above. Trim the strips flush.
