Shark Lady Suncatcher



Supplies:

For younger children, precut tissue paper squares and shark/diver silhouettes.

- Laminating sheets
- Tissue paper squares in different shades of blue and white
- Black construction paper
- Scissors
- Shark and diver silhouettes (see Printables)

Directions:

1. Using the shark templates provided, children trace shark shapes onto black construction paper using pencils or white crayons. Cut them out.
2. For each child, lay down one of the sheets of film sticky side up. They fill in the entire background with squares or torn bits of tissue paper. A few different colors make for a nice contrast.
3. Place silhouettes on the tissue paper background. No need to worry about them sticking as the second sheet of film will seal them in place.
4. When the picture feels complete, lay another piece of film on top, sticky side down. This will seal the picture.
5. Use a hole punch to make two holes in the top of the suncatcher and string through a piece of ribbon for hanging.
