ON October 20, 2015, the Federal Highway Administration signed the Type 2 Categorical Exclusion pertaining to the Project Development and Environment study that was conducted by the Florida Department of Transportation for the above-mentioned project. The purpose of the study was to examine the reconstruction of Ellis Road as a four-lane facility in conjunction with building an extension to Interstate 95 (1-95) and constructing a new interchange with 1-95 at Ellis Road in Brevard County. By signing the Type 2 Categorical Exclusion document, the Federal Highway Administration accepted the location and design concept of the selected alternative.
