Lindsey Barber's photography was reviewed for exhibit approval. A motion was made by Spearman to approve *Gopher It*, *Neon Pier*, *Bluesy*, *Up Up and Away*, *Drifting with the Tide*, *Rolling #1*, and *Rolling #2* for exhibit. Seconded by Herndon. Motion carried.
