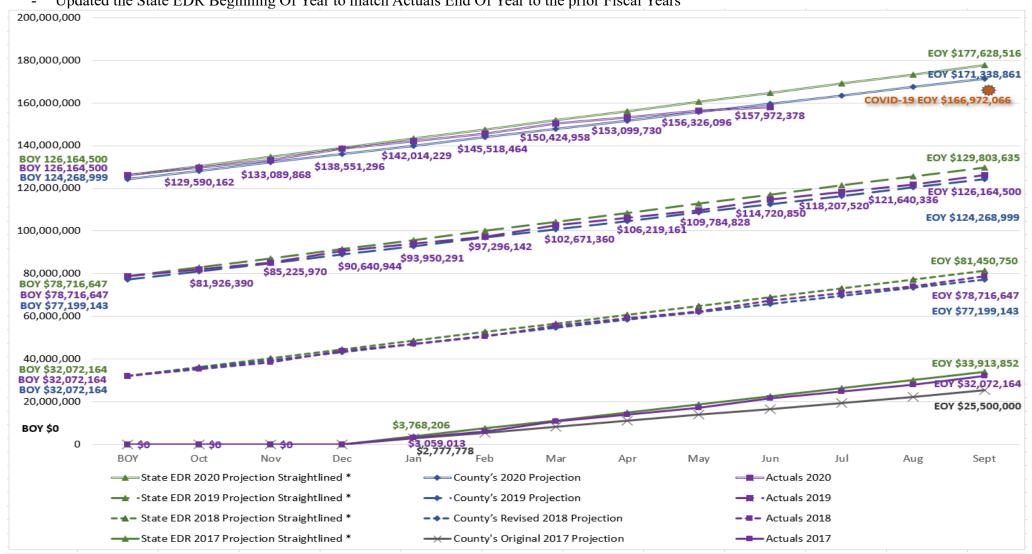
## Save Our Indian River Lagoon Revenues Cumulative Graph Fiscal Year 16-17 to Current Fiscal Year
