The purpose of the Public Meeting is to:

- Conduct a review of the fiscal year 2020-2021 HOME Investment Partnerships Program and Community Development Block Grant Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report,
- Review proposed funding priorities for Fiscal Year 2021 - 2022, and
- Obtain citizen's input on the strategies, priorities and proposed funding priorities.

Annually an Action Plan is developed to utilize funds received from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development to fund local Community Development Block Grant and HOME Investment Partnerships Program programs and projects based on the current Consolidated Plan's established needs and priorities. Information obtained will be used by the Affordable Housing Council to develop funding recommendations which will go to the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners, before being submitted to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development. Two public hearings will be held to solicit comments.

The Community Development Block Grant Program's primary objective is the development of viable communities by providing decent housing; a suitable living environment; and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low and moderate income. Brevard County anticipates funding in the amount of \$1,443,617 for fiscal year 2021 – 2022.

HOME Investment Partnerships Program funds are received by Brevard County on behalf of the Brevard County HOME Investment Partnerships Program Consortium, consisting of Brevard County and the cities of Titusville, Cocoa, Melbourne and Palm Bay. The breakdown of HOME Investment Partnerships Program funds for fiscal year 2021-2022, is as follows: Brevard County \$509,767.09, Titusville \$137,376.72; Cocoa \$81,562.93; Melbourne \$261,694.64; and Palm Bay \$258,002.62. These funds may be used for housing activities such as; acquisition, construction and rehabilitation of housing, purchase assistance, and direct assistance to renters.

Agencies, groups and individuals are invited and encouraged to attend these meetings and share their ideas and comments with county staff, advisory councils and the general public.
